

# **Project Overview**

- Ottawa has embarked on the largest infrastructure project since the building of the Rideau Canal
- The City of Ottawa will be the ultimate Owner
- Rideau Transit Group (RTG) \$2.1 Billion Fixed
   Price Contract
- Rideau Transit Maintenance (RTM) 30-year maintenance contract





# **System Capacity**

- Initial ridership capacity of ~11 000 passengers per hour/per direction
- Initial frequency of every 5 minutes or less in peak hours
- Travel time under 25 minutes, including stops



# **Putting the Train into Service**

- RTG anticipates turning over the system to the City by November 2, 2018
- Once the City accepts the system, OC Transpo has a number of complex activities to complete before putting the light rail system into service
- The City anticipates service will start in November 2018, as long as RTG achieves its requirements.








# Stage 2

- Consists of 40+ kilometers of rail and 24 new stations
- 3 extensions: Confederation West, Confederation East & Trillium





#### **Benefits**



14,000 less vehicles on road during rush hour



70% of Ottawa's population within 5 km of O-Train system



**GHG Reductions:** 110 000 tonnes



\$7.1B less in commuting costs





More than 30 km of new multi-use pathways (MUPs)



\$3.8B Economic Impact: 21,000 person-years of employment generated










# **New Orchard Station - Footprint**







# Richmond Road Complete Street



- Additional tree planting where possible
- MUPs/cycle track coordinated with Byron Linear Park design
- Raised intersections for safety/fewer lanes to slow traffic speeds
- > Detailed design will address opportunities for on street parking

#### Construction

- Cut and Cover technique for tunnel construction
- Limits on noise and vibration during construction and operation
  - City by-law and contract requirements
  - Contractor innovation/incentives

#### Issues

- Noise and vibration ... mitigation measures
- Connectivity during construction/operations
- Air quality impacts
- Construction site staging/mobilization








# **Track Mitigation**

- Direct Fixation is prescribed in Schedule 17
- DB Co is required to undertake a Noise and Vibration analysis to determine if further mitigation is required












#### KEY DESIGN ELEMENTS

RAISED CONCRETE PEDESTRIAN CROSSING, CONNECTING THE CHURCH ENTRY TO THE PARK

OTTAWA STAGE 2 LIGHT RAIL

- CONTINUOUS CONNECTION FROM PARK PATHWAY TO THE PEDESTRIAN CROSSING
- TWSI AT INTERSECTION OF RAISED PATHWAY AND PARKING LOT AND PARK PATH RAISED 2.0m CONCRETE SIDEWALK FROM MAIN
- ENTRY TO WEST ENTRY 3.4m WIDE CONCRETE SIDEWALK, EAST TO
- 3.4m WIDE CONCRETE SIDEWALK, EAST TO PARKING LOT, WITH PEDESTRIAN WALKWAY IDENTIFIED TO DRIVE ISLE
- MAXIMIZE ON-SITE PARKING
- 6 ACCESSIBLE PARKING SPACES
- PROVIDE 3 ADDITIONAL PARKING SPACES IN SOUTHEAST CORNER OF OUR LADY OF FATIMA SCHOOL PARKING LOT
- PROVIDE LAY-BY ADJACENT TO WEST ENTRY FOR PASSENGER PICK UP AND DROP OFF
- ACCOMMODATE SERVICE VEHICLES AND PARA TRANSPO MOVEMENTS THROUGH PARKING LOT
- NEW CONCRETE BASE FOR CHURCH SIGNAGE, AT NORTHWEST CORNER OF PARKING LOT, RELOCATE EXISTING SIGN
- EXTEND ELECTRICAL CONNECTION FROM EXISTING SIGN TO NEW SIGN
- PROVIDE RAISED CONCRETE CURB ALONG NORTH FACE OF PARKING LOT
- PROVIDE ON-SITE STORMWATER MANAGEMENT, WITH CB AND LEAD TO STORM SEWER IN BYRON LINEAR PARK
- PEDESTRIAN HEIGHT POLE MOUNTED LIGHTS (2), FRAMING THE FRONT ENTRANCE
- . 6 ADDITIONAL DECIDUOUS TREES



# **Adjacent Street Parking**

#### **Knightsbridge Road**

**South:** weekend parking to be permitted


**North:** weekend parking already permitted

#### **Lockhart Avenue**

**East:** weekend parking already permitted

**West:** weekend parking to be permitted except in school bus loading zone










# Tunney's Bus Loop
